

Firstly, a **BIG** THANK-YOU to all the friends and well wishers of Charles Wong for your wonderful and overwhelming support and kind donations.

As per the attached fund statement, the total donation amounted to RM 46,741 and after Charles' medical treatment cost, a remaining amount of RM 40,495 has been deposited into his account to help towards his well being.

Now, an update on the medical check-ups and treatment Charles had undergone after his discharge from the KK Queen Elizabeth Hospital on the 26th June 2006 in a very poor physical condition; and he could not see at all.

Charles was sent for an eye check-up on 30 August 2006 in KK by eye specialist Dr. Mona who confirmed that he had totally lost his sight in both eyes.

On the 27th October 2006 Charles was sent to Singapore Mount Elizabeth Medical Centre for a complete eye check-up by eye specialist Dr. Yap. The final results showed that Charles' complete loss of vision is due to severe brain cell damage and that it is permanent. Charles' medical case was also reviewed by a neurosurgeon, Dr. Yeo of Singapore Mount Elizabeth Medical Centre. He concluded Charles' had suffered a severe brain cell damage due to a stroke and, short of a miracle, recovery would not be possible, and present and near-future medical technology has no procedure to correct Charles' medical problem.

Whilst hope for a western medical cure had been given up, it was decided, no matter how small the chance of success, to try an eastern treatment which was suggested for Charles. On the 20th November 2006 Charles was sent to Johor Baru to undergo Chinese honey-bee-sting acupuncture treatment for two weeks. No improvement was observed after his return from the treatment.

Charles has recovered his physical health very well but is suffering from short term memory loss and remains blind. His mother has taken him into her home to look after him better.

Meanwhile, a claim to SOCSO for permanent disability is being pursued on Charles' behalf. Other insurance policies, though not for large amounts, that Charles has taken out are also being followed up. Registration with Society For The Blind and Social Welfare is being looked at in the hope that these institutions can assist Charles to better look after himself.


Charles' family members have expressed their deep gratitude to all of you for your kindness and generosity. All of us now can only hope and wish for the best for Charles.
